Effectively balancing high-levels of performance with scalability was another key pre-requisite for the new WLAN solution. etc.venues caters for thousands of people every day, and so needed a solution that could cope with the huge levels of bandwidth this environment requires. Branigan continued, "Mobile devices, of every kind, are coming onto the network and demanding capacity for the internet, but also bandwidth intensive multimedia applications. The solution had to be able to cope with 980 people using the network at any one time, and not just cope but ensure their experience is a good one."
